- Be an exemplary student
- Be an ACFLI member in good standing with good attendance to all meetings
- Currently be enrolled in a high school culinary program or two/four-year postsecondary culinary program or a professional level certificate program
- Have a career goal of becoming a chef, pastry chef or in the hospitality field
- Have official transcripts (sealed) from your culinary program & High school transcript showing current GPA
  - Two letters of recommendation from industry and/or culinary professionals. (This person may not be related to the applicant in any manner)
- Professional Picture in Chef Coat & Toque
- Current portfolio of culinary work, food and active community services.
   (NOTE- Only <u>portfolio format</u> will be accepted! Include pictures and as much material as possible, include documentation of awards, certificates etc.)
- Letter of acceptance or application to post-secondary school
  - Recipients selected by American Culinary Federation Long Island Chapter Scholarship Awards Committee will be announced at the ACFLI End of Year BBQ in June.
